EARLY STAGE 1 NEWS

Welcome back to all our students and we hope you had a wonderful holiday.

Students will have the opportunity to visit Stage 1 this term as part of a transition program. I am sure they will find this experience exciting as they join in the variety of activities planned.

A quick overview of the content ES1 will be studying this term includes:

English - daily 'warm ups' will continue incorporating letter, sound knowledge, blending, sight words and tracking activities. Students will also continue with modeled, guided and independent reading and writing activities. Geography and History work will focus on 'The importance of places to people' and we will be looking at farms and growing cycles as part of this. The Science topic for this term is 'What's it made of'. Mr David Newham, our Aboriginal Education Worker will be sharing his knowledge and expertise with ES1 this term, supporting the units of work that we will be studying. We are very much looking forward to his input. The focus for health and personal development is on safe and healthy living including road safety education. We will be visiting the Life Education Centre later this term and this will allow students the opportunity to consolidate skills and knowledge on staying safe and healthy.

Maths - students continue to work on early arithmetical strategies as part of the TEN program as well as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills.

We will continue to work on reading and writing the numbers to 20 correctly (those teen numbers are tricky!) and counting to 30 from any given number. Volume and capacity will be covered along with mass and area. Focus this term for sport will be on skill development using a variety of equipment, incorporating these skills into modified games such as T Ball and learning about the importance of an active lifestyle. With the warmer months now upon us please ensure your child brings their hat daily along with a water bottle. Students will continue to create, make and explore in creative art activities and enjoy music and drama. Don't forget all students have a weekly visit to the library, so lots of opportunity to exchange books. What an action packed term with so many things to look forward to!

Keep those home readers coming in and encourage your child to write at every opportunity, making lists, notes, cards etc for friends and family.

We are looking forward to a very productive and rewarding Term 4.
